When asked upon what basis was this the case when there was project and other funds as yet unspent, which may be earmarked for those projects at year end and when challenged as to whether the reserves included Earmarked Reserves no answer was given.

**RESOLVED** that a named vote take place to accept the recommendation of the Budget and Oversight Committee to:

- Ensure that the accounts of the Town Council are totally up to date before a budget is set for 2023-2024. It is hoped that this will presented to the February Full Council, but as yet the amount of work is to be determined. Members noted that Cllr. Harrison had done a considerable amount of work on the finances of the Council but Locum Town Clerk Vanessa Voysey would go back to 1<sup>st</sup> April 2022 to update the records as required on the Edge Accounts system
- Accept the recommendation to agree that the Precept for 2023/2024 be £150,000 representing a 4.7% increase
