POLICE REPORT FOR MONTH OF APRIL 2019

- 23. PSCO Freya Newton gave the Councillors a verbal report detailing the number of incidents in the village over the last 12 months. She stated that during the year crime figures reported to the police were as follows:
 - Anti-social behaviour = 98
 - Burglaries = 13
 - Criminal damage = 35

She added that the number of anti-social behaviour incidents report was normal for an area the size of Haxby and that the number of burglaries was low. She also said that a recent spike in reported crimes had now died down. She ended by saying that Operation Joypad was coming to the area. This is where the police go around testing for unlocked doors on houses.

Cllr Richardson then raised the topic of young people cycling without care and attention and pointed out that this was likely to lead to accidents.

The police report for April 2019 was RECEIVED.

CASH CHECK
